DAAD HELMUT- SCHMIDT-PROGRAMME
(MASTER'S SCHOLARSHIPS FOR PUBLIC POLICY AND GOOD
GOVERNANCE - PPGG)

The DAAD funding programme “Helmut-Schmidt-Programme (Master’s Scholarships for Public Policy and Good Governance - PPGG)” (PPGG) is designed to train future leaders in politics, administration, economy, and in non-governmental organizations.

Applicants with a first academic degree (16 years of education) not older than six years may select from all participation master’s degree courses, most of which are run completely in English. At present, scholarships for the following courses are offered:

- **Social Protection**
- **Development and Governance**
- **Public Policy**
- **Peace and Conflict Studies**
- **Management in Nonprofit Organizations**
- **Development Studies**
- **Governance and Public Policy**

The application period for participating higher education institutions is from 1 June until 31 July 2025.

Applications to the master's courses should be submitted to the university directly, including the DAAD application form (to be found at the mentioned website). All master’s courses have their own selection criteria (degree, grades, language skills, practical experience, etc.) that must be met in addition to the DAAD’s selection criteria.
