#### 3 R D INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP FOR LEADERSHIP AND SECURITY




# EDUCATIONAL VISIT EDUCATION OFFICERS BASIC COURSE (EOBC)

The Resource Persons of this workshop was Dr. Rao Arsalan Khushnood, Assoc Prof, HOD Research, NUST Islamabad.




