SOP: PhD UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION AND RESEARCH COMMITTEE (UERC)

1. **Gen:** It is imperative to have an adequately regulated process in research phase of PhD degree programme where a research proposal, thoroughly debated by the experts, should be approved and progress of research properly monitored / documented. Only those scholars, measuring up to threshold research output requirements should be allowed to continue further.

2. **Aim**. This SOP is devised to lay down guidelines to monitor overall research performance of a PhD scholar on regular basis and provide guidance to improve the quality of research.

3. **Composition**. University Examination and Research Committee (UERC) constituted by QEC in Coordination with respective HoDs for each PhD scholar after passing the Comprehensive Examination will be composed as under:-

a.	Dean FCS	:	Chairperson
b.	Concerned HoD	:	Member
C.	Thesis Supervisor	:	Member
d.	Co-supervisor	:	Member
e.	One External Subj Expert	:	Member
f.	Director QEC	:	Member

4. **UERC Process**. UERC process is attached at **Anx-A**.

5. **Meeting:** The committee will meet minimum once in a semester (or on req basis) to monitor, evaluate and document the scholar's progress during the previous semester.

6. **Functions and Duties of UERC:** Functions and duties of UERC shall be as under:

- a. **Approval of Research Topic**. Consider and recommend the final research topic and research proposal duly endorsed by the Supervisor and Departmental PhD Committee for approval of the ASRB.
- b. Change of Research Topic. Consider and recommend the request of the PhD Scholar for change of research topic duly endorsed by Supervisor for the approval of ASRB.
- c. **Research Ethics**. Sensitize the PhD scholar on ethical considerations during the conduct of research. The candidate must convince the UERC



in the first review that research poses no physical, emotional, psychological risk to the participants, the implementing institution (NDU) and the candidate. If there are any risks, UERC to demand from the PhD Scholar to present a workable plan to manage and minimize the risks.

- d. Change of Supervisor. On the request of University or the PhD researcher UERC may recommend the change his/ her supervisor for the approval of ASRB. In case of delay in the meeting of ASRB, President NDU may approve change of supervisor which will be subsequently confirmed by the ASRB.
- e. **Submission of Progress Report.** Submit progress reports of all PhD Scholars, who are in research phase, to the ASRB after approval of the President NDU through Examination Branch twice a year.
- f. Evaluation of PhD Scholar's Research.
 - (1) Respective HoD (as member of UERC) shall inform in writing all eligible PhD scholars, appearing for his/her first UERC, about types of reports i.e. adverse, absent & fail status and their impact on the academic career as under:
 - (a) Earning two consecutive adverse reports or total three adverse reports will merit cancellation of admission.
 - (b) Absence from a scheduled UERC meeting will be considered as 'Fail'.
 - (2) PhD scholar will formally present the research progress in every semester in UERC meeting, which will critically examine the direction, regular progress and quality of research completed during the period of review (format of the presentation is att at Anx-B).
 - (3) The committee will debate all aspects of the proposal specially finalization of research topic, hypothesis, research questions, conceptual model/framework, validity of data collection instruments, choice of data analysis tools, expected results or contribution to the body of knowledge area at the end.
 - (4) The committee may pass the scholar straight away, pass with advice of few improvements or reject the proposal. In the last case the scholar will be deemed to have availed one chance and will be given last chance to come back with new proposal after 1 - 2



months on the given date. Proceedings of the committee will be recorded (in hard & soft form) and kept with the respective HoD for use in the next meeting.

- (5) In case, performance report of the scholar is found adverse/ below required standards, the scholar will be informed in the committee meeting and a written report will also be sent at scholars e-mail/last working address by respective HoD.
- (6) The committee will provide appropriate guidance and document it, in case, the scholar's direction and quality of research are not considered in line with the target research proposal.
- (7) The scholar's progress shall be graded in a quantified way by Supervisor, Co-Supervisor, External Subject Expert and respective HoD; Evaluation Proforma and check list is attached as Anx-C and D respectively.
- (8) While defending the research proposal during first UERC meeting, scholar will submit a time line of his work, clearly identifying targets of research to be presented / reported in the next meeting of the UERC.
- (9) There will be 02 x progress reports of the scholar in each year and presented/discussed in semester wise UERC meetings by the members and documented by the supervisor.
- (10) In case of non-availability of concerned supervisor, subject expert & HOD, UERC will not be held/ executed and will be rescheduled through ION/email.
- (11) Special UERC meeting (on justifiable grounds) may be convened after the approval from Dy President NDU.
- (12) Record of reports will be maintained both in hard and soft form by the respective dept.
- 7. Cancellation of Admission & PhD Candidature on the Basis of UERC Reports and Evaluators Remarks. Under following conditions, case shall be processed for cancellation of Admission & PhD candidature of a PhD scholar by the respective dept through QEC and Registrar Office:
 - a. If a scholar is absent without any valid reason or fails to present his/her work



before the committee on the pre-announced date and has been graded fail by default.

- b. If a scholar reported absent or fails to present his/her work before the committee two consecutive times or total of three times.
- c. If a scholar gets two consecutive adverse reports or total of 03 x adverse reports.

8. **Compliance of Doctoral Seminar Suggestions**. UERC will ensure the compliance of amendments proposed during doctoral seminar and recommend his/her thesis for foreign evaluation. If UERC is planned in next semester and student has completed all required steps, then special UERC may be arranged to help scholar to avoid next semester fee just because of UERC.

9. **Publication of Research Article**. A PhD Scholar is required to meet publication requirement of relevant research article, after the PhD research topic is approved by the ASRB, as under: -

- a. At least: One research article in HEC recognized X category journal or two research articles in Y category journals
- b. The PhD researcher shall be the first author of these publications.
- c. The research article shall be relevant to the PhD research work of the PhD researcher.
- d. The article shall be published after approval of the research synopsis.
- e. The article shall be published in a relevant research journal.
- f. The published article must be written by not more than three authors.

The article has to be submitted to Director QEC (as UERC member) for vetting before submission of PhD dissertation to the Exam branch.

10. This issues with the approval of President NDU and shall come into force with immediate effect.




