Eligibility Criteria & Basic Information to Apply

- Intermediate or equivalent from an accredited Board/Institute with a Minimum 2nd Division.
- Merit shall be determined on the basis of previous academic records (SSC+HSSC), ETC Entry Test and Interview.
- Candidates awaiting result can also apply on provisional basis, their merit shall be determined on HSSC-Part-I marks. They shall be required to submit the complete results with min 2nd Div by **10-Sep-2018**, failing which their provisional admission shall stand cancelled.
- Candidates having foreign certificates (O/A' Levels) should provide their equivalence from Inter Board Committee of Chairmen (IBCC) with the admission form. In case the IBCC equivalence is delayed, merit shall be determined with minimum eligibility criteria of 2nd Div, an undertaking to this affect shall be required to be submitted, applicants are required to submit the IBCC equivalence with min 2nd Div by **10-Sep-2018** failing which their provisional admission shall stand cancelled.
- 2x Seats per department are reserved for FATA, 1x for Balochistan & Gilgit Baltistan quota, respectively. Copy of valid domicile/ local certificate is required to be submitted.
- Admitted candidates shall be required to submit their respective board attested certificates by the end of the 1st semester.
- Submission of original ETC test (HAT-UG 'A') results are required for consideration of merit.

Eligibility Criteria & Basic Information to Apply

- BA/BSc (14 year education) or its equivalent is relevant subject with minimum 2nd division in annual system or 2.0/4.0 CGPA in semester system from HEC recognized University/DAI.
- Candidates awaiting result can also apply on provisional basis, their merit shall be determined on BA part -I Marks. They shall be required to submit the complete result with min 2nd Div by **10 Sep 2018** failing which their provisional admission shall stand cancelled.
- Merit shall be determined on the basis of previous academic records (HSSC + BA/BSC), ETC entry test and interview.
- Candidates having foreign certificates should provide their equivalence from HEC with the admission form in case the equivalence is delayed merit shall be determined with minimum eligibility criteria of 2nd division & undertaking to this affect shall be required to be submitted, applicants are required to submit the HEC equivalence with minimum 2nd division by **10 Sep 2018** failing which their provisional admission shall stand cancelled.
- Candidates are required to bring original documents at the time of Interview and submit their HEC attested degree during the 1st semester.
- Submission of Migration certificates from last attended university by **10 Sep 2018**.

Eligibility Criteria & Basic Information to Apply

- Masters or equivalent degree/BS (4 years) in the relevant field (16 Years Schooling) with minimum 2nd Division in annual system /2.5/4.0 CGPA in semester system from a HEC recognized University/ DAI.
- Candidates having foreign certificates/ degrees should provide HEC equivalence of Min 16 Years Schooling and conversion of the letter grades into marks from HEC/ respective University for consideration of merit calculation. Applications without numerical ratings shall be evaluated with minimum eligibility criteria of 2nd Division for annual based degrees / CGPA 2.5 for semester based degrees. In case of CGPA, its shall be converted to its respective percentage.
- Valid GAT(General) with minimum 50 marks or ETC HAT (PG) with 50 marks.
- Complete Transcript is required to be submitted with Admission form submission.
- Merit shall be determined on the basis of previous academic records (BA/BSc+MA/MSc OR BS), NDU Entry Test and Interview.
- Candidates are required to bring original documents at the time of Interview and submit their **HEC attested Degree** during the 1st semester.
- Applicants can apply in two programmes, however they must appear in both entry tests & interviews for consideration of merit.
- Submission of Migration certificate (Original) from last attended University by **10-Sep-2018**
- 1x Seat per department are reserved for FATA. Copy of valid domicile/ local certificate is required to be submitted.

Masters or Equivalent in Strategic Studies, Strategic and Nuclear Studies, Diplomatic Studies, Defence & Strategic Studies, International Relations, Journalism, Political Science, War Studies, Security Studies, International Politics, Governance Studies, Geography, Space Science, History, Art and science of Warfare, Psychology, Economics, Sociology and Anthropology, Criminology and Law. Eligibility Criteria & Basic Information to Apply

- M.Phil/M.S degree (18 years education) or its equivalent in a relevant subject with minimum 1st Division in annual system or 3.0/4.0 CGPA in semester system from HEC recognized University/ DAI.
- Candidates having foreign certificates/ degrees should provide HEC equivalence of min 17/18 years education and conversion of the letter grades into marks/CGPA from HEC/ respective University for consideration of merit calculation. Applications without numerical ratings shall be evaluated with minimum eligibility criteria of 1st Division for annual based degrees / CGPA 3.0/4.0 for semester based degrees. In case of CGPA, it shall be converted to its respective percentage.
- Valid ETC test (NAT PG) Management Sciences & IR with minimum 60 marks from NTS or ETC HAT (PG) with 60 % marks prior to the NDU Entry test / interview.
- Complete Transcript is required at the time of Admission form submission. Result awaiting cases will not be considered.
- Candidates applying for admission are required to submit PhD Research Proposal with admission form including a statement of interest (5-8 pages) that addresses the reasons for choosing the PhD programme and the field of study
- Candidates are required to bring original documents at the time of Interview and submit their HEC attested Degree within the 1st semester.
- Merit shall be determined on the basis of previous academic record (MS/M.Phil) and Research Proposal/ Interview/ test.
- Submission of Migration Certificate from last attended University by **10-Sep-2018**.
