1	Vanier Canada Graduate Scholarships	<p>To be considered for a Vanier CGS, you must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • be nominated by only one Canadian institution, which must have received a Vanier CGS quota; • be pursuing your first doctoral degree (including joint undergraduate/graduate research program such as: MD/PhD, DVM/PhD, JD/PhD - if it has a demonstrated and significant research component). Note that only the PhD portion of a combined degree is eligible for funding; • intend to pursue, in the summer semester or the academic year following the announcement of results, full-time doctoral (or a joint graduate program such as: MD/PhD, DVM/PhD, JD/PhD) studies and research at the nominating institution; Note that only the PhD portion of a combined degree is eligible for funding; • not have completed more than 20 months of doctoral studies as of May 1, 2018 (see calculating months of doctoral studies below); • have achieved a first-class average, as determined by your institution, in each of the last two years of full-time study or equivalent. 2	IDB-KAUST Joint PhD Scholarship Program	<p>The candidate must be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A citizen of an IDB member country (visit the IDB Merit Scholarship Program for a full listing of member countries) • Age not over 35 years • Engaged in full-time employment in an academic, research or development institute in the home country and the application is nominated by that institution • Meets the eligibility criteria of the IDB Merit Scholarship Program • Have a firm admission offer at the KAUST for a PhD program <p>Selection of candidates under this joint program will be within the scope of the IDB Merit Scholarship Program. Interested candidates must follow these criteria and procedures to apply for the scholarship.
